

Welcome to Bridgewater Lakes

To ensure a safe and more enjoyable experience for all site users the following code has been developed.

- The swimming area is provided for safer swimming. Supervise children at all times.
- Slow to 5 knots within 50 metres of people in the water, and any other vessels including human powered vessels. (kayaks, canoes, SUPs etc.).
- Human powered vessels are encouraged to remain in the 5 knot zone (lake edge) when power boats are operating.
- Respect all wildlife and stay clear of waterbirds.
- Respect the local environment and safety of others by taking your litter home.
- Respect the aids to navigation and avoid contact as they make the waterway safer.
- Sounds travels over water. Respect other sites users by being mindful of boat noise and music.
- Boats and skiers returning to shore should signal their intention with a raised arm.
- Boats and skiers leaving shore must give way to boats already on the lake.
- Taking turns skiing. Reducing boat numbers makes a more enjoyable experience.
- Slow and retrieve ropes close to shore once you are passed the boat ramp access.
- Skiers should raise an arm to be more visible and show they're OK when in the water.
- Ski observers should raise an arm when a skier is in the water.
